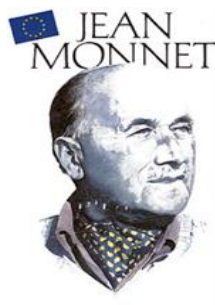

- Margins: top, bottom and right, left – 20 mm.
- Type Times New Roman, 14, line spacing – 1.5
- Paragraph indent - 1.25 mm.
- Articles should contain the title, abstract and key words.
- Preparing the bibliography, please use the Chicago bibliographic system for citations, notes and bibliography
- The article should contain name(s) of the author(s) (first name and last name), scientific degree, academic rank, university position, affiliation telephone, e-mail address.
