The objective of the Forum is to promote the dialogue between the academia and the civil society, the stakeholders of the European integration processes in the EaP countries. Forum will provide an open platform for exchanges between academia, policymakers and civil society. It will bring together the participants to exchange experience, discuss key challenges and to institutionalize a dialogue platform for young generation of scholars in European Studies from the EaP countries. The EaP experts and the EU invited speakers will discuss, with the audience, the main achievements of the Eastern Partnership and future prospects for the region.

The Forum will comprise of the three consequent events:

June 6th. Pre-conference workshop for junior scholars **“What makes a good research project: multidimensional approach”**

The workshop will be a blend of the “Ted-talk” style interventions (teasers) on the research essentials, grant writing, public speaking, hard/soft skills development etc. performed by the invited trainers and practitioners.

June 7th. Conference **“The 10th anniversary of the Eastern Partnership: lessons learnt, current challenges and future perspectives”**

The Conference will be organized in a dynamic debate on the most important and timely issues within the EU-EaP context. The Conference program will be structured to allow for study, debate and critical reflection on the different aspects of the relations of the EU with respective EaP countries, the implementation of Association Agreements, the key domestic and external challenges hampering EU-EaP contacts, and future scenarios for EU-EaP relations.

June 8th. Open Discussion with policy-makers, civil society representatives.

The panel discussion will be a live onstage talks amongst the panelists who will share their views the subject of the Conference in front of the participants.

Largely, the International Forum "**Reflecting on the future of the EU- EaP relations: Young Scholars' Voice**" will offer an excellent opportunity for the scholars (young researchers in particular) to exchange information and experiences about the on-going development of the European Studies in their countries and beyond. It will generate new and important insights in the projected thematic areas, making advantage of the diverse areas of expertise of the target group and participants, and their mutual commitment to the EU-EaP field of providing awareness and competence.

The target group and participants: the EU-EaP Academy participants, the EU and EaP countries' speakers, local academic community, policy-makers, NGOs and wider public.

Educators and wider public with an academic and professional interest in the EU-EaP relations are invited to join the Conference. We will also consider participation by the Master students whose abstracts are accepted.

Extended Abstract Format must be of a 2-4 pages and will be included in the e-version of the Conference proceedings.

Extended Abstract should be prepared in English or Ukrainian. If it is written in Ukrainian, it must include an annotation in English (200-250 words)

It is the responsibility of authors to ensure that a submitted text is **carefully proofread**.

Extended Abstract includes the following:

1. Annotation in English if the text in Ukraine
2. 2-4 Key words
3. Discussion and results or data obtained
4. Conclusion
5. References
